## **Course Contents**

All scientists have to write. Some enjoy it, others dread it. This course provides tools and strategies to enhance your writing and to overcome difficulties in the writing process. We will address the following topics:

- Publishing in Evolutionary Biology: how to write and communicate in the reviewing process
- Writing concise and attractive abstracts: how to structure and summarize complex topics
- Addressing different types of audience
- Find and keep motivation for writing projects; tools to improve focus

We will work on these topics by means of exercises, group work, input talks, discussions and individual feedback.
